







Within Africa, millions of people are moving from rural areas to cities. The bubbles below show African cities with more than 4 million inhabitants in 2010 and 2025 (projected).


SENDING MONEY HOME: TOP 10 REMITTANCE RECIPIENTS

Emigrants from Africa send home billions of dollars, and for some countries, these remittances make up a large share of GDP.





NET MIGRATION
